


ADVANCE 4 SPEED CASSETTE

FITTING THE CASSETTE


To fit the cassette, you will need a cassette tool. Lightly grease the freehub body FHB, then fit each spacer and sprocket in the order shown. (fig. 1) Each component except spacer 2 SS2 has to be aligned to the spline on the FHB to fit. Position the cassette tool in place to egage with the lockring LR then tighten to 45Nm.

REMOVING THE CASSETTE

To remove the cassette, you will need a cassette tool and a chain whip. Position the cassette tool in place and then the chain whip. Undo the lockring.







FITTING THE SINGLE SPEED SPROCKET

To fit the single speed sprocket, you will need a cassette tool. Fit the wider spacer SS1 first followed by the sprocket then the thinner spacer SS2. (fig. 2) The spline of the freehub body FHB has to align with the sprocket to fit. Position the cassette tool in place to egage with the lockring LR then tighten to 45 Nm.

REMOVING THE SINGLE SPEED SPROCKET

To remove the single sprocket, you will need a cassette tool and a chain whip. Position the cassette tool and then the chain whip. Undo the lockring.
